San Xavier District Site Visit

The first stop will be at the San Xavier District of the Tohono O'odham Nation riparian restoration site called the Wa:k Hikdan. At this site we will tour the various features and discuss how this site was visioned and constructed with community and partners. Next, we will drive to a location at the Santa Cruz River just north of the Wa:k Hikdan at I-19, and San Xavier Road, where staff will show how the restoration work to the south and other community actions have helped reestablish native habitat in the river bed. The District staff will also discuss some of the ongoing work to enhance the environment including watershed and invasive species management.
